**GOFFS FRANCE SALES TALK** 

## BERRY SNAPS UP PROMISING LYNDAAR

Ireland took home the top offering at yesterday's Goffs Vente d'Ete. Trainer Frank Berry, who seems to splash out on at least one decent horse here every year, went to €160,000 late in the day for Lyndaar (Lot 171) from Nicolas Clement's Chantilly stables. A very progressive four-year-old son of Barathea, winning his last two starts, the horse has been fourth in Listed class and has a flat rating of 91. He looks the type to progress again when sent jumping. His dam Lobmille (Mill Reef) has produced four Black Type performers in the Listed winner Lobyist (Mtoto), Listed-placed Hurricane Louis (Fabulous Dancer), American Gr.1-placed Lone Bid (Priolo) and Gr.3 scorer Lil's Jessy (Kris).

Just a minute earlier Keven Borgel went to the round €100,000 mark to secure **Halkin Street** (Lot 170). The horse managed to win on his only run at two and has few miles on the clock. In addition, the shrewd Christian Maillard always leaves plenty of gas in the tank and his new trainer will surely have him winning again soon, the flat seeming to be his immediate objective.

#### **OGDEN EXPANDS HIS TEAM**

Robin De La Garde (Lot 53), a three-year-old Garde Royale gelding presented by Haras du Feuillard (on behalf of Haras de Nonant Le Pin) was one of a good handful bought by Bertrand Le Meteyer on behalf Sir Robert Ogden. Garde Royale has the Gr.1 winner Carling and Oaks runner-up Gazelle Royale to his credit but is better known as a jump sire. The gelding is a full-brother to Robin Des Champs who was a Listed winning jumper. His half-brother Robin Des Pres was nearly as good, winning four times over the sticks and was placed in Listed class. A fine, big sort, he will surely be given all the time he needs to develop, having been bought on behalf of one of the UK's leading NH owners. He wasn't cheap but he was all quality, the hammer falling at €145,000.

Shortly into the sale Le Meteyer went to €92,000 for Lot 8, a two-year-old colt named Calideo (Video Rock) from l'Elevage des Forges. He had a nice frame to grow into and hadn't yet been broken-in. His dam Dona Cali (Dom Pasquini) won three times over jumps and already has a Mansonnien three-year-old in training. His grandam Dhaucali (Dhaudevi) was also a useful jumper, having won three times in this sphere.

**Turgeon** was a sought after stallion, as demonstrated by **Lot 22**, a well-grown two-year-old colt consigned in

superb condition by Nicholas and Isabelle Simon's Haras des Marais. He is a half-brother to **Tropical de Cuta** (**Kadrou**) who was placed fourth at Auteuil in Listed company. Once again it was Betrand Le Meteyer signing for Sir Robert Ogden, the hammer falling at €58,000.

#### PIPE SECURES MARCEL

French agent Hubert Barbe, who spent most of the day at Champion trainer Martin Pipe's shoulder, went to €125,000 for Marcel (Lot 94), an AQPS four-year-old gelding from the Chantilly stables of Francois Cottin. The lightly-raced son of Bateau Rouge has just had two spins over hurdles, finishing second and then third at Auteuil. His dam Une Risette was a Listed-class steeple-chaser, who won ten times in total and has bred a winning jumper in the shape of the mare Indecise (Cyborg).

#### **HIGHFLYER BUSY**

Surprisingly, Highflyer Bloodstock were often left as underbidders but did last longest when securing **Roi** de l'Odet (Lot 148) for the tidy sum of €80,000, David Powell signing the docket. From the stables of leading Sennones trainer Joel Boisnard, the four-year-old gelding has a flat rating of around 80 having notched up five victories in 2003. For a son of **Grape Tree Road** he stays very well, having been placed over a mile and a half. He should make a decent hurdler as he also has plenty of speed, having won over a mile on two occasions.

Earlier in the session Highflyer paid the more modest sum of €65,000 for Lot 77, No Regrets (Turgeon), from SCEA de la Placiere. The three-year-old gelding is out of the winning hurdler Beluda (Beyssac) and has all the credentials to make it in the jumping game coming from the family of Kingwell Hurdle winner Valfinet.

Most of the more expensive purchasers were destined for a trip across the Channel, but this wasn't the case with **Montecatini** (**Lot 97**) from trainer JPJ Dubois, this going to Swedish owner Erik Soderberg of **Mirio** fame. A late-developing son of **Adjayt**, the four-year-old AQPS gelding had just three runs on the flat before being sent straight over fences at four – he has been placed on both his starts in this sphere. Still a novice, it won't be long before he finds a winning opportunity. Having seen off all the usual players, Soderberg signed the ticket when the hammer fell at €78,000.

Trade was strong all day, this being reflected in the rise in average of 25.9%, and more significantly, a strong rise in the clearance rate to 76.7%. Not surprisingly managing director Eric Hoyeau expressed himself more than satisfied with the days work, particularly with the middle market which held up well especially towards the end of the session.

## FIRST CLASSIC WINNER FOR LAROCHE

German bred filly **Sword Roche** recorded a first Classic win for her sire **Laroche** (**Nebos**), when she triumphed in the Austrian Oaks, two and half lengths ahead of homebred **Tamdana**. German-trained Sword Roche, fourth in the Gr.3 Schwarzgold-Renne, is a half-sister to Gr.3 Furstenberg-Rennen winner **Sword Local** (**Local Suitor**).

Laroche, who began his stallion duty in Gestut Hof-Ittlinen alongside his half-brother **Lando**, has just completed his second year at the Czech-based Mimon Stud. Miloslav Vlcek

## FOXHOUND COLT CELEBRATES HIS BIRTHDAY IN STYLE

Steve's Champ, a leading two-year-old in his native Chile, celebrated his birthday in style – Chilean born horses change on 1st July – by gaining his biggest win since his move to Scandinavia when he scored in the Listed Polar Sprint Cup at Ovrevoll. The four-year-old son of Foxhound has settled well into the Northern Hemisphere and finished second to Musadif (Shadeed) in the Listed Norsk Jockeyklubs Sprintlob at the same course last month.

In Chile, he won the Gr.3 Selaccion de Potrillos and the Gr.3 Clasico Victor Matetic Fernandez as a juvenile.

## REVENUES TO ROLL IN FOR UK RACECOURSES FROM OVERSEAS

UK racecourses backing Racing UK are set for a financial windfall, following the successful sale of their TV pictures to a number of major overseas markets.

Phumelela Gold Enterprises (PGE), Racing UK's international media rights partner, has announced to the Johannesburg Stock Exchange that it has concluded exclusive agreements for the broadcast of racing from Racing UK's 30 courses to Sri Lanka, the Caribbean, Russia and its adjacent territories. These agreements, together with existing revenue producing operations, meet the guaranteed minimum revenues identified in the May 2004 agreement between Racing UK and PGE. Further international simulcasting agreements are anticipated in the coming weeks.

#### **ENNIS TO CHAIR VAT WORKING GROUP**

Jeff Ennis MP, Joint Chair of the Parliamentary All Party Racing Group, has been appointed to head a BHB Working Group which will seek a further renewal of the valuable VAT Registration Scheme for racehorse owners.

The scheme, worth some £20m to Racing and Breeding annually, enables racehorse owners to register their racing activity as a business for VAT purposes. The scheme, launched in 1993, was extended by Government in 1997 and 2002 and is next due to be reviewed by Customs and Excise in 2005.

# DANZIG'S SUPERB JULY CUP RECORD

On the eve of one of world's greatest speed contests, the Darley July Cup, it is well worth looking at what have been Europe's best speed influences in the recent past. The table that accompanies this article examines the sires that have had 50 or more runners in the last five years in Europe. And it concerns itself with only those stallions that have recorded an average winning distance for their three-year-old and older progeny of less than a mile and half a furlong. Conceivably, there may be stallions just outside this cut-off point that are likely to come up with top speedsters but we have to draw the line somewhere.

If ever a race and stallion were made for one another, it must be the July Cup and **Danzig**. During his heyday – which has not yet concluded, I might add – Danzig has sired six winners of this Gr.1 sprint. In 1986 **Green Desert** was the first of the July Cup-winning Danzigs and he was followed by **Polish Patriot** (1991), **Hamas** (1993), **Anabaa** (1996), **Elnadim** (1998) and **Agnes World** (2000). Two of his grandsons – **Owington** and **Oasis Dream**, both by Green Desert – were successful in 1994 and last year. And as if that's not enough, he was also the grandsire of the 2001 winner **Mozart**, who was by the 1989 third-placed finisher **Danehill**.

Given such dominance, which is extended to many such sprints and mile races, Danzig – believe it or not has been quiet by his own exalted standards in recent years. Still, he is by far the best source of quality speed in Europe around at the moment, that is if you can get hold of one of his offspring. Such is his dominance that his percentage of Group winners for the period is three times that of his closest pursuer and his ratio of Stakes winners is nearly double.

In second place on our leaderboard is **Storm Cat**, who, as well as getting a top 10-furlong performer such as **Giant's Causeway** in Europe, is also quite capable of siring a **Catrail** or **Dietrich**.

The horse that is giving these two Americans most to do is **Pivotal**, a grandson of **Nureyev** another sire with a rich July Cup heritage, siring **Soviet Star** and **Stravinsky**. We have extolled the virtues of Pivotal here before, particularly his ability to produce high-class runners from lower grade mares. Pivotal's speedsters include **Kyllachy** and **Somnus**, but he is far from a one-dimensional horse as the likes of the fillies **Chorist**, **Golden Apples**, **Humoresque**, **Megahertz** and **Silvester Lady** – all winners at Group or Graded level at 10 furlongs and beyond – will attest.

The Nureyev connections continues with the fourthplaced sire – the top-class miler **Spinning World** – who is far better at producing milers rather than sprinters even though his stamina index is less than some good sires of sprinters, including Green Desert.

This veteran son of Danzig, who occupies fifth position on the leaderboard, won the July Cup and supplied two winners of the same race, plus many more talented sprinter/milers as well. Whilst it is true that unwavering patronage got him past some sticky points in his career, there are many glad to see that he did survive, none more so than those who have investing in his stallion sons in recent years. It wouldn't be at all surprising if Green Desert's best stallion sons end up producing runners with more stamina than he did.

In joint-sixth position is **Bahamian Bounty** and **Indian Ridge**. Followers of Bahamian Bounty could easily argue a case for a higher fee for this son of **Cadeaux Genereux**, particularly as his percentage of Stakes winners in Europe is almost one point better than his own sire. His best runner is the 111-rated **Naahy**, who picked up the sevenfurlong Ballycorus Stakes recently. Indian Ridge meanwhile is in the twilight of his career and was the 'Pivotal' of his day. In the period under review he has got 28 Stakes winners and many of them have proved more than capable beyond their sire's average of 7.6 furlongs.

A newcomer to this table is **Fasliyev**. An outstanding sire of two-year-olds last year, the Fasliyev three-year-olds have looked less impressive this term, but his early start has meant that his ratio of Stakes winners is still better than Cadeaux Genereux, **Royal Applause** and **Efisio**, three very capable sires.

#### REPORT INTO NZ RACING INDUSTRY UNVEILED

A new report on the New Zealand racing industry has illustrated its importance to the economy.

The racing industry contributes more than NZ\$1.4 billion worth of economic activity annually and creates the equivalent of 18,000 fulltime jobs, a New Zealand Racing Board report released this week says.

The "Size and Scope of New Zealand Racing Industry" report released yesterday reveals that the direct economic impact of the racing industry is NZ\$445 million, with the industry itself sustaining over 9,000 fulltime jobs every year. When the flow-on economic impacts are included, the contribution of the industry rises to NZ\$1.4 billion, or about 1.3% of New Zealand's GDP.

As well contributing significantly to GDP, racing generates more than NZ\$60 million in tax annually from wagering, in addition to the taxes paid on wages and other expenditure.

The report shows the underlying strength of the industry is in provincial regions, where racing and breeding are mainstays of society and a dynamic contributor to local employment. In areas like Waikato, Southland, Manawatu-Wanganui and Canterbury, racing is hugely important.

The report also reveals racing's strong links with the community. More than 30,000 people are involved in the breeding, rearing and training of racehorses and greyhounds and another 10,000 participate through racing clubs and wagering. In addition, 330 community organisations share race club facilities or resources and over 240 community events are supported by race clubs.

More than 1 million people attend New Zealand race meetings each year, spending NZ\$54.7 million on betting, food, drink, transport and accommodation according to the report.

## STRONG INTERNATIONAL FLAVOUR TO JULY CUP

The £250,000 Gr.1 Darley July Cup, highlight of the last day of the July Meeting at Newmarket next Thursday has entries from Japan, Hong Kong, Australia and the USA, as well as France, Ireland and Britain.

Yesterday morning, **Seeking The Dia**, trained in Japan by Hideyuki Mori, worked very well on the July Course ahead of his bid to emulate **Agnes World**, who won the race for Mori in 2000. Travelling companion and fellow entrant **Dorubako** also worked.

Yesterday, trainer David Oughton confirmed that his challenger from Hong Kong, Cape of Good Hope, will run in the six-furlong showpiece. Meanwhile the big Australian hope, Exceed And Excel, is expected to work on the Al Bahathri gallop on Saturday morning. Lydgate, trained by Eoin Harty in the USA, completes the impressive line-up of inter-continental challengers.

The European defence features the French pair **Porlezza** and **Crystal Castle**. From Ireland, Aidan O'Brien seems likely to saddle **Antonius Pius** and all of Britain's top sprinters are entered in the race, including **Patavellian**, **Avonbridge**, **Fayr Jag**, **Frizzante**, **Kheleyf**, **Airwave** and **Balmont**.

## HELMSMAN FILLY TOPS FIRST SUMMER SALE

The inaugural Barretts Summer Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age, held on Tuesday, was topped by Lovely Journey (Lot 58), a juvenile daughter of the Gr.1 winner Helmsman (El Gran Senor), who completed two furlongs in 21.5s at Monday's breeze-up. Consigned by Havens Bloodstock Agency Inc, the Californian-bred filly was purchased by Howard Roberts Farm for \$110,000. Her dam, Spin Around (Commadore C) has bred two winners and is a winning full-sister to the Stakes scorer Hooting Star and a half-sister to the Gr.3 victor Mountain Top (Trapp Mountain).

Overall, 53 juveniles sold for \$848,300, average of \$16,006 and median of \$10,000. Forty older horses sold for \$406,500, average of \$10,163 and median of \$5,250. Altogether, 93 horses realised a total of \$1,254,800, average of \$13,492 and median of \$8,000. Nineteen lots failed to sell.

Sixth at Newmarket on her only previous outing, the winner is a member of the first North American foaled crop of Gainesway resident **Luhuk** (**Forty Niner**), who has sired fifteen known Stakes winners in Argentina, where he stood from 1996 onwards. During his racing career, Luhuk won three races in Great Britain, was second in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes and third in the Gr.3 Rose of Lancaster Stakes.

Nordhock is the first foal out of the dual American juvenile winner Starlight Dreams, a Black Tie Affair half-sister to the multiple Listed winner Matahif (WassI) and the Listed-placed Keswa (Kings Lake).
